

How to obtain prescription medication for your pet

There are multiple ways to purchase prescription medication for your pet. Pricing and availability may vary depending on how and where you obtain your pet's medication.

1. Purchase from your regular veterinarian

You can call or visit your regular veterinarian's office to see if they carry the particular medication you're looking for. Please make sure to bring the written prescription we have provided so that they know exactly which medication your pet needs.

2. Purchase online

There are multiple websites where you can purchase prescription medications. Simply type in the name of the medication and mg strength into the search engine of your choice. Depending on the medication, you can order through a human online pharmacy or veterinary online pharmacy. These sites require a written prescription via email or fax or they may send us a medication request form. Please see the website of your choice for more detailed instructions. We recommend purchasing only from pharmacies in developed countries.

3. Purchase from a human pharmacy

You cannot purchase veterinary only medications from human pharmacies

Many of the medications we prescribe are also used in humans. This means they are available from regular pharmacies such as Walgreens, Publix, Costco, CVS, and Target. Please feel free to call around to different pharmacies to see who is most affordable. All human pharmacies will require a written prescription unless we call the medication in directly from our office. If you do not know if your pet's medication is veterinary only, please ask one of our staff members.
